

Important Information of Guajataka Camp (also see <http://www.bsapr.org/guajataka.htm>)

- Accommodations:
 - Open cabins
 - Bunk beds
 - Bathrooms with hot water
 - Large meeting area
 - Picnic areas
 - Hiking trails
 - Lake (with canoes)
 - Swimming pool (bring your swim suit)
 - Little light at night (bring a flashlight)

- Weather:
 - Warm during the day (between 80-85°F); cool at night (65°F)
 - You should bring a sleeping bag
 - High Relative Humidity
 - It may rain (bring a raincoat or umbrella)

- Wildlife
 - Mosquitoes are not common at the camp (no other significant biting insects in the area).
 - Centipedes and scorpions are uncommon and are not considered dangerous.
 - No venomous snakes.
 - Avoid mongooses and rodents since they are potential carriers of rabies.
